FLIGHT DAY: Depart from the United States or Canada

Your vacation is about to begin! Spend your first night aloft and arrive ready for an unforgettable trip.

ARRIVAL DAY: Arrive in Johannesburg / Begin your Pre-Trip Extension

Start off your first day in Johannesburg right by having a representative holding a VBT sign greet you at the airport. They will escort you on a short walk to your Johannesburg hotel, located within the airport. From here, you may discover this charming city at your leisure.

DAY 1: Travel to Hoedspruit

After breakfast, return on your own to the domestic terminal in the Johannesburg airport. Once there, catch your one-hour flight to Hoedspruit Airport (HDS). On arrival, travel by van to the lodge (approximately one hour). Following your arrival at the lodge, enjoy lunch, check in, and relax in your comfortable room with a view of the wilderness. In the late afternoon, enjoy high tea, then head out on your first game drive, accompanied by a ranger and a tracker. You'll return to the lodge in time to freshen up before dinner.



DAY 2: Continue your Pre-Trip Extension

Enjoy a full day on the grounds of the game reserve. The lodge offers both an early-morning and late-afternoon game drive, the latter of which extends into a night drive with a stop for sundowners, so you can watch the sun set over the African horizon. The reserve is blessed with a diverse array of animal species, and the off-road game drives provide a unique safari experience that allows you to get tantalizingly close to Africa's wildlife. You have some time at leisure to relax, or take a dip in the swimming pool. Your city documents will note additional activities that your lodge has to offer. All meals are at the lodge today.

DAY 3: Travel to Cape Town

This morning, you have an opportunity for one last game drive followed by breakfast before transportation is provided to the airport. Lunch is on your own today – you can grab a meal at the Hoedspruit Airport or onboard your flight (approximate flight time is two hours and 45 minutes). Upon arrival in Cape Town in the late afternoon, a VBT representative will meet you and assist with your transportation to the hotel (approximately 30 minutes). After check in the rest of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure—perhaps explore the city, rest up in the hotel, or select a local restaurant for dinner. We provide detailed city information to help you plan your day.
